

Qatar Charity Humanitarian Photography Competition.

As part of Qatar Charity's commitment to foster the culture of humanitarian work among individuals in Qatar and all over the world, we are pleased to announce an international photography competition in cooperation with (Soura Forum).

coinciding with the Qatar Photography Day, the competition aims to shed the light on the different facers of the humanitarian work from the field bringing aspects of human suffering, hope and transformation to the general audience.

The competition is open to all photographers given the topic of the competition is humanitarian, relief or charity work. Themes may include:

- natural disasters
- conflicts,
- refugees and IDPs
- disadvantaged communities/ vulnerable groups

Contest terms:

1. Participation in the competition open participants from all over the world.
2. The focus of the competition is humanitarian work in all its fields.
3. Participants should submit at least 3 photos and no more than 5 photos as a maximum.
4. Images submitted must be in JPEG or JPG format, high quality, the shortest side of the image should not be less than 3000 pixels and the print quality should be 300 dpi
5. additions or digital merging are NOT allowed in submitted image.

6. Only basic adjustments are allowed, such as cropping the image, adjusting the tilt, colors, lighting, sharpness of the image, and removing distractions.

7. Black and white or color photos are approved.

8. Participating images should not contain any signature, logo, frame, or any symbol or shape that does not belong to the original photo at the location where it was taken.

9. Under no circumstances should you erase or change any of the EXIF image data.

11. The deadline for receiving photos is Saturday, May 7, 2022. Results announced within 30 days from that date.

12. Competition Prizes:

- First place: \$5,000, five thousand US dollars
- Second place: \$4,000 four thousand US dollars
- Third place: \$3000, three thousand US dollars

13. Any images that are inappropriate or contradicting with customs and traditions in the State of Qatar will be excluded.

14. It is required that the submitted photos were taken by the same participant and it is not permissible to participate under more than one name, and the photos submitted must not infringe the copyrights, trademarks or any moral ethics, rights of privacy or intellectual property rights of any person or entity. Participants will

be responsible for any consequences that may result from any infringements.

15. The jury has the right to reject any of the participating photos without the need to notify nor justify rejection.

16. The committee has the right to make any changes it deems appropriate to the terms and conditions at any time and without referring to the participants.

17. The decision of the jury on all matters relating to the competition shall be final and binding on all participants.

18. The cash value of the prizes will be transferred via approved cash transfer methods, with the winner being responsible for paying any taxes or fees (including income tax) that may be levied on any prize he may obtain by participating in the competition.

19. The sponsor has the right to use the participating images in any way it deems appropriate in publications, exhibitions, advertising and charitable campaigns, etc., while preserving the intellectual rights of the photographer.

20. Only Qatari courts are authorized to resolve any dispute that may arise.

21. By participating in this competition, you acknowledge that you have read and understood all the terms and conditions and that you agree to abide by it, as any participant / image will be disqualified in case of any infringements.
